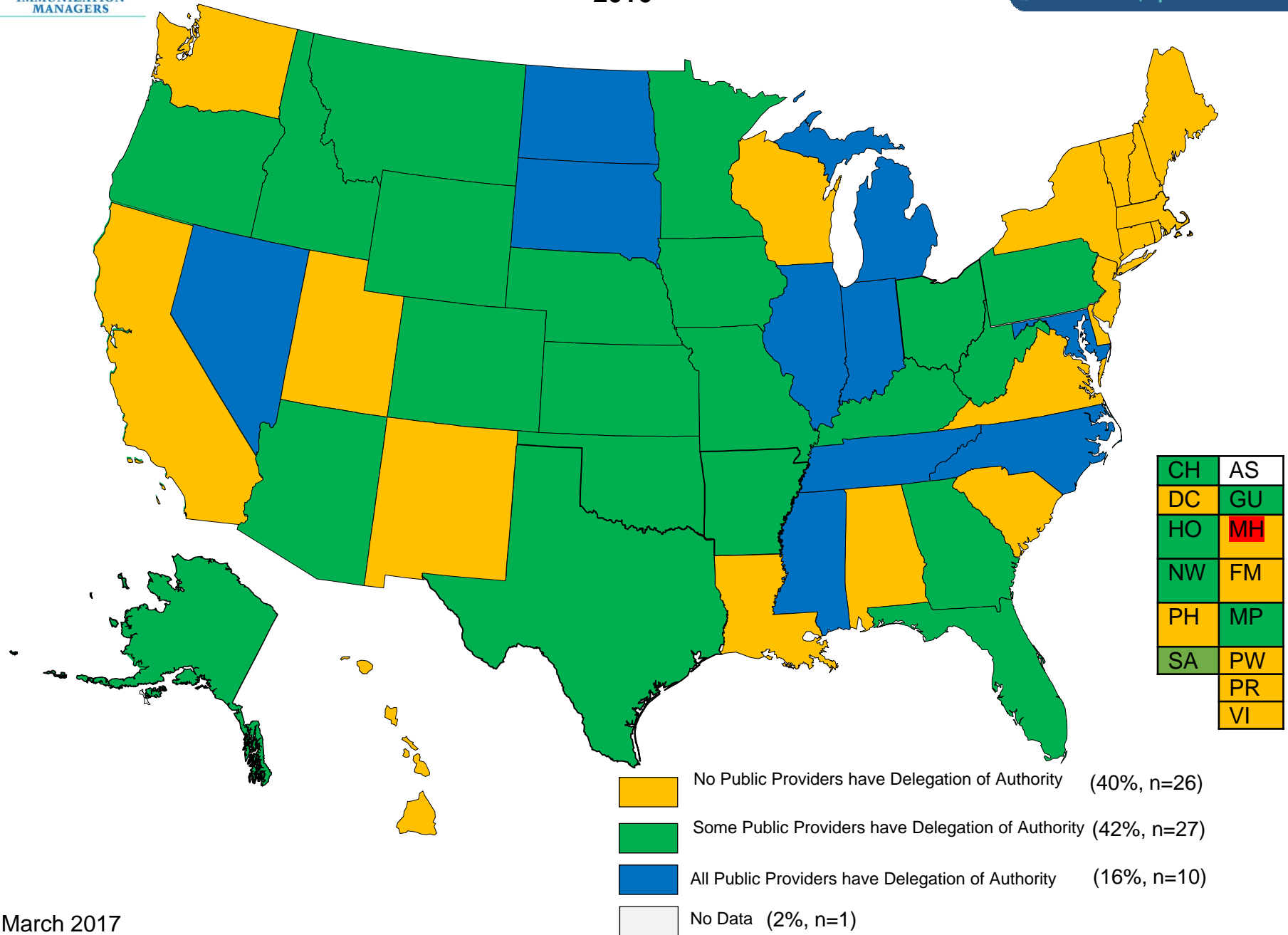

Important definitions:

- FQHC/RHC is defined as Federally Qualified Health Centers /Community/Migrant Health Centers/Rural Health Clinics that receive grants under the Public Health Service (PHS) Act, and "lookalikes“ which meet the same qualifications but do not actually receive grant funds.
- Public providers are defined as a state, district, county or city public health department operated clinics where vaccines are administered and other public clinics which provide immunization, such as a publicly funded nonprofit neighborhood clinic
